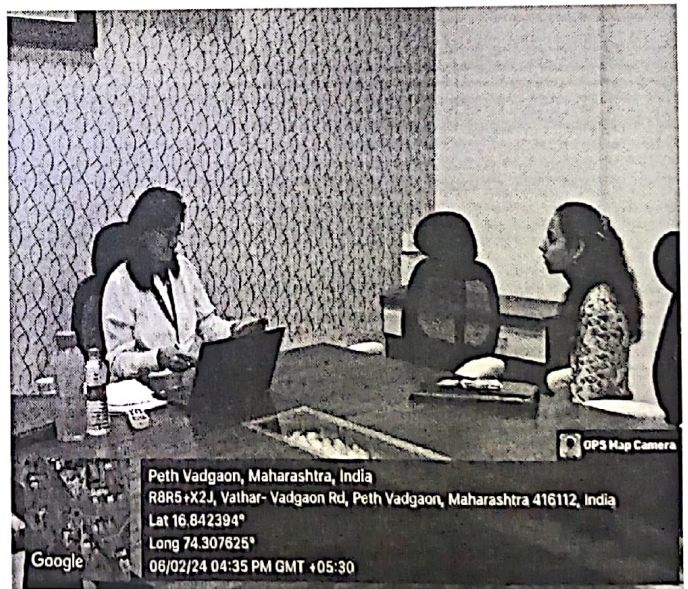
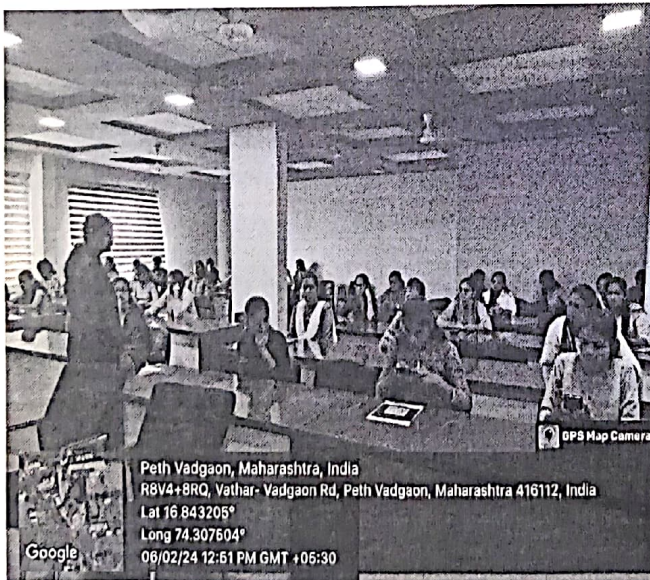
A) Placements

1. MOU with Kolhapur Cancer Center:


