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## INSTITUTIONAL NEWS

### WORLD PHARMACIST'S DAY 2022



World Pharmacist Day was celebrated on 25th September 2022 by Ashokrao Mane College of Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon, Women's College of Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon, and Ashokrao Mane Institute of Diploma in Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon, in collaboration with the Kolhapur District Chemist Association and Vadgaon Chemist and Druggist Association. The event aimed to recognize the significant contribution of pharmacists in patient care and community well-being. It emphasized the role of pharmacists as accessible healthcare professionals and promoted community engagement.

Throughout the week, various activities were organized to raise awareness and educate the public. A Pharma Rally, Blood Donation camp, and Street Play were among the events conducted. The students and staff were divided into groups and visited various departments during the visit, including the Department of Production, Quality Control, Quality Assurance, cleaning areas, Packaging, and Storage.

The successful organization of the visit was made possible due to the invaluable support of the college's management, Principal Dr. S. V. Patil, Academic Incharge Dr. S. A. Bandgar, and Incharge of Industry Institute Interaction Cell Ms. S. S. Suryawanshi.

It aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical applications, offering the students a firsthand experience of a real-world pharmaceutical setup.

### NATIONAL SOCIAL SERVICES (NSS) CAMP

The Ashokrao Mane College of Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon organized a successful seven-day National Social Service (NSS) camp in Padali, in collaboration with Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The Labor Sanskar camp took place from February 20 to February 26, 2023, and saw the participation of 50 dedicated volunteers. The inauguration ceremony was graced by Dr. Mrs. Vibha Patil, the Sarpanch of Padali village, and Mr. Shivaji Jadhav, the Deputy Sarpanch. Numerous esteemed individuals including Mr. Ravindra Patil, the former Deputy Sarpanch, Shri. V. B.

Patil, the Head Master of Vidya Mandir Padali, Mr. Ajit Patil, a Gram Panchayat member, Mr. Kondiba Pawar, Mr. Nivrutti Gaikwad, Dr. S. V. Patil, the Principal of AMCP, Peth-Vadgaon, Dr. S. A. Bandgar, the Academic Incharge, and NSS Co-ordinators Mr. A. P. Jadhav, Ms. S. V. Nhawkar, and Mr. Prashant Patil were present during the inauguration.

During the camp, Mr. A. P. Jadhav, the NSS Co-ordinator, provided an overview of the activities conducted over the course of seven days. On the first day, a morning procession called "Prabhat Feri" took place, followed by a village cleaning initiative. The second day featured an eye check-up and health camp in collaboration with Ashokrao Mane Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital, Vathar Tarf Vadgaon. This day also included various medical tests such as haemoglobin, sugar, blood group detection, and blood pressure measurements, benefitting over 82 individuals. The third day involved cleaning the school premises and a lecture on "Yug Yugin Maharashtra" by Dr. Sachin Kondekar, the Principal of Smt. Indira Gandhi Secondary School, Peth-Vadgaon. On the fourth day, in celebration of Sant Gadgebaba Jayanti, the village was cleaned, and



a session on "Yoga and Pratyakshya" was conducted by Shri. S. B. Bagal, a Senior Lecturer at Ashokrao Mane Institute of Diploma in Pharmacy, Peth-Vadgaon.

The fifth day witnessed tree plantation in the village and school area. Additionally, as part of the "Wall of Humanity" initiative, the volunteers collected old clothes from door to door for donation to orphanages, while also conducting health surveys. ## INDUSTRIAL NEWS

### Cough syrup suspected of killing 12 kids in Cameroon might be Made in India



A variety of cough syrup suspected by Cameroonian authorities of killing a dozen children in the central African country in recent months bears markings indicating it was made in India.

Photographs of a box of Naturcold medication show a manufacturing license number matching that of Riemann Labs Pvt. Ltd., based in Indore in the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. The photos, provided by Eko Eko Filbert, a regional health official in Cameroon, don't show a manufacturer's name.

The drugs in the photo "look like ours," said a director at Riemann, Navin Bhatia, in a phone interview. He said Riemann follows strict quality controls and couldn't have made tainted medicine, and that counterfeiting is common.

The revelation raises the prospect of a third mass death event linked to exported Indian cough syrups in less than a year. Medicines from two other Indian companies killed more than 60 children in Gambia and about 20 in Uzbekistan last year. In those cases, the syrup medications were found to have been contaminated with two toxic chemicals, ethylene glycol and diethylene glycol. Two more Indian companies are suspected of making similarly tainted syrups found in Liberia and in the Marshall Islands, although no injuries have been reported in those cases.

"Based on your questions, we have sent a team to investigate and we are waiting for the reports," an official at the Madhya Pradesh Food and Drugs Administration. Propylene glycol and glycerin are key raw materials for syrups. Riemann buys these chemicals only in sealed containers from name-brand manufacturers, and then hires a third-party lab to test them prior to use.
